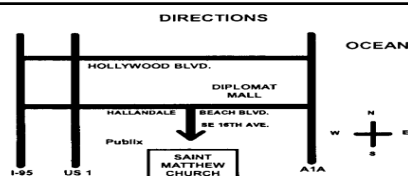

Justice Corner January 30, 2011 Living the Beatitudes

The Beatitudes offer a challenging key to the Christian life summarized by Zephaniah: "Seek justice, seek humility." Jesus' values differ greatly from those of our contemporary culture where greed, prestige, power, security, wealth, and status are often assumed to be signs of success and happiness. The Gospel message is clearly "counter-cultural."

The Beatitudes remind us of Catholic Social Teaching:

- Our preferential option for the poor
- Our special concerns for those who suffer
- Our hunger for justice in the world and in its institutions and structures
- Our concern for mercy and justice in our criminal justice system
- Our profound respect for life in all its forms
- Our care for the earth as a gift from God to be shared by all
- Our passion for nonviolence and peace
- Our willingness to face opposition and live counter-culturally
