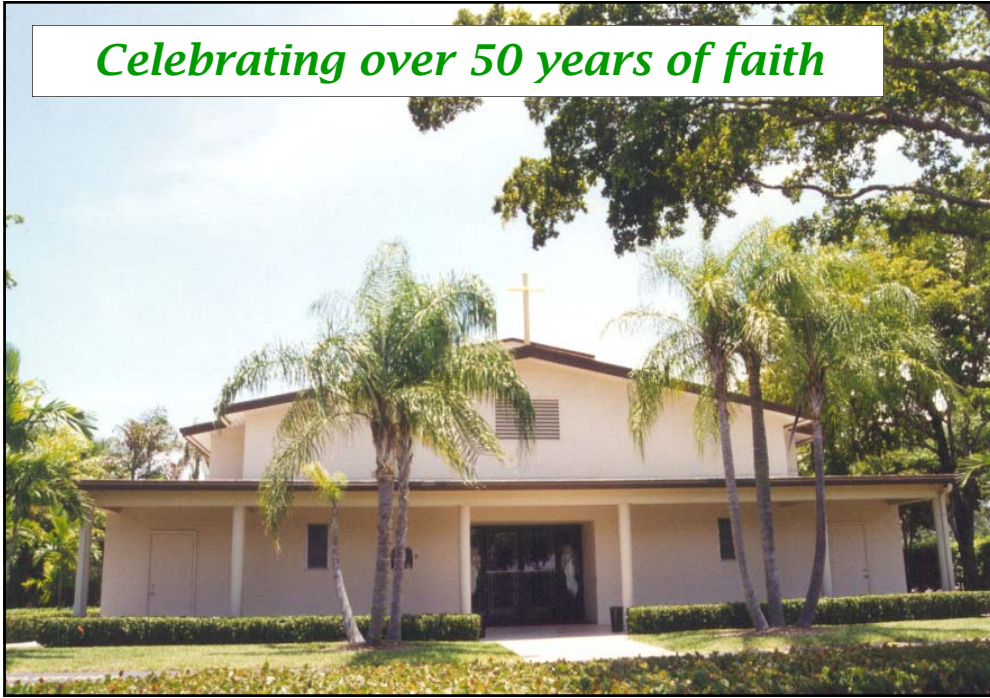

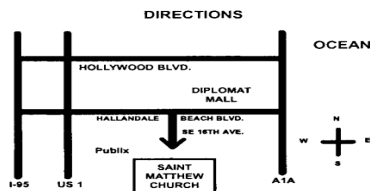

ST. MATTHEW PARISH REGISTRATION If you attend Mass here at St. Matthew, we encourage you to register with us. Please stop by the Parish Office to fill out the simple registration form or download the form from www.saintmatthewcc.com. We urge you to get involved with our ministries and, as a stewardship parish, ask that you use your Offertory envelopes. If you are not a registered & active member of our parish, Baptisms, Marriages, Sponsor Certificates and other documents needed from the Church will take longer to obtain and, in some cases, not possible. You must be attending Mass regularly & be an active member within the parish. **Call the Parish Office 954-458-1590.** **BAPTISMS AT ST. MATTHEW** Baptisms in English take place on the third Saturday of each month. Baptisms in Spanish take place on the second and fourth Saturdays of the month, November through May. If you would like to have your child baptized call the Parish Office. **To have your child baptized at St. Matthew, you should be a registered parishioner.**

FOLLOW FAITHFULLY

When Elijah calls Elisha to follow him, Elisha goes back, momentarily, to finish some business at home. But note that he does not leave the work to be done by those at home, nor does he plan to come back and finish it himself. He recognizes in Elijah's call that he must follow faithfully and not look back.

Psalm 16 celebrates the loving protection of God for those who depend on God's love and mercy. God is our portion and cup, in a line seen by Christians as a poetic reference to Eucharist, and God will not abandon us to death and corruption, but will call us into the holy Presence forever. This could be seen as resurrection, something that was not universally believed in the days before Jesus. We are assured that if we go forth in confidence to follow God's daily call, we will not be shamed or abandoned, but will find the life we seek.

Slave or Free?

Today's Scriptures invite us to leave everything and follow Jesus on the Way, the freedom that allows us the ability to "serve one another through love." Paul reminds us that Christ's freedom must be truly liberating - personally, socially and politically.

Has our political freedom set us free or enslaved us? Has our economic freedom made us slaves to the consumer culture? Has freedom of the press created a culture dominated by corporate powers and their limited perspectives? Have we become enslaved by capitalism, consumerism, racism, etc.?

Jesus calls us to be free enough to focus on a vision of life, love and service. We must be aware of those things that get in the way of this freedom and choose to walk in the values, life and joy of Jesus Christ. As Paul says: "Brothers and sisters: For freedom Christ set us free; so stand firm and do not submit again to the yoke of slavery."
